A portion of Section 10, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, W.M., more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the one-fourth section corner on the west boundary line of said Section 10, thence along the east and west center line of said section (said line making a southeasterly angle with the west boundary line of said section of $37^{\circ}40'18''$) south $87^{\circ}40'18''$ east 1272.64 feet to the southwesterly marginal line of Brookside Boulevard; thence south $43^{\circ}20'10''$ east along said southwesterly marginal line 663.51 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continuing south $43^{\circ}20'10''$ east along said southwesterly marginal line 85 feet; thence, at right angles thereto, south $46^{\circ}39'50''$ west 260 feet; thence at right angles thereto, north $46^{\circ}38'50''$ east 260 feet to the true point of beginning; (being known as Lot 9, Block 4, of the unrecorded plat of Brookside Addition to Lake Forest);

SUBJECT to the following limitations and restrictions running with the land, to-wit: That said property, or any part thereof, shall be used for residence purposes only, and shall be occupied only by persons of the white race, except that servants not of the white race, but actually employed by a white occupant, may reside on said property.

DESCRIPTION

This plat of "Lake Forest Park" embraces the following land: Beginning at the S. e. cor. of Secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10; thence S. 86° 16' 14" W. 52° 11' 89" ft. to the cor. of Secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11, thence N. 02° 05' W. 135° 56' 03" ft. to South edge of Lake Forest Boulevard, thence on the arc of a curve to the left with radius of 513.80 ft. for 426.91 ft., thence S. 25° 08' 40" W. 63.00 ft. thence on the arc of a curve to the right with radius of 676.02 ft. for 258.05 ft., thence N. 48° 00' 35" W. 645.94 ft., thence on the arc of a curve to the right, with a radius of 1410.30 ft. for 297.73 ft., thence S. 62° 06' 47" W. 1514.81 ft., thence N. 85° 25' 54" W. 102.63 ft., thence N. 01° 13' 02" W. 1685.20 ft. along center line of Sec. 2 to South edge of the Serpentine, thence S. 50° 23' 45" W. 654.21 ft., thence on the hub of a curve to the right with radius of 1004.98 ft. for 205.44 ft., thence N. 87° 14' 3.30" W. 251.07 ft., thence on the arc of a curve to the right with radius of 12.44 ft. for 204.39 ft., thence N. 78° 32' 0" W. 75.82 ft., thence on the arc of a curve to the left with radius of 763.31 ft. for 498.59 ft., thence S. 65° 03' 13" W. 203.36 ft., thence on the arc of a curve to the right with radius of 1117.02 ft. for 204.95 ft., thence S. 75° 34' W. 84.65 ft., thence on the arc of a curve to the right with radius of 511.21 ft. for 212.64 ft., thence N. 80° 57' 15" W. 88.69 ft. to Sec. line between Secs. 9 and 10, thence due North along Sec. line 2650.84 ft. to place of beginning. Being all in section 10 of T. 26 N. R. 4 E. M. in King County, Washington.


